#### WHAT IS ICERD?

International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination (ICERD) is a United Nations Convention that condemns discrimination based on race, colour, descent, nationality or ethnic origin.

Singapore ratified the ICERD on 27 November 2017. This underscores our commitment to work towards a society free from racial discrimination.
