

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION ON SG YOUTH ACTION PLAN**

The SG Youth Action Plan builds upon past engagements and key findings from the Youth Conversations series, to crystallise our youth's vision for Singapore in 2025. Through the SG Youth Action Plan, the youth and Government will partner on programmes and policies that bring us closer to the vision they have of Singapore in 2025.

The diverse SG Youth Action Plan panel comprises 16 leaders from the people, public and private sectors who have made significant contributions in the youth space. It will be co-led by Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth & Ministry of Communications and Information Sim Ann, and co-founder and Chief Executive Officer of Timbre Group Edward Chia.

Panel members will take the lead in driving the SG Youth Action Plan. This includes (i) consolidating the findings of past engagements and in consultation with youth, shape the vision of our future Singapore, and (ii) provide recommendations on policies that are in line with the vision, as well as champion more projects involving youth to create change and build a better future together.
